Manchester Islamic High for Girls is an independent all girls 11 – 16 secondary school, founded in 1991 and located to the south-east of Manchester city centre, in Chorlton. We are a relatively small school of approximately 240 pupils, with a two form entry, making for a strong sense of belonging and community amongst staff and pupils alike. The school was rated outstanding at its last two inspections (February 2011 and October 2015). Our aim is to deliver an outstanding curriculum within an Islamic environment.

We are seeking to appoint an inspirational and highly motivated teacher of Computing and ICT. The ideal candidate must be able to teach Computing and ICT at both Key Stage 3 and 4. From September 2017 we will offer both Computer Science and Business Studies at GCSE, but in Year 11 2016-17 the courses taught are Business and Communication Systems and the Cambridge Nationals Diploma in ICT; the successful candidate would be expected to deliver all these courses. Please note that, due to the size of the school, there is only one teacher of Computer Science/ICT, who is responsible for the day to day management of the subject, but the school has a strong system of support in place to assist and advise staff.

The successful candidate will:

- Have an appropriate teaching qualification and be qualified to degree level
- Be a Computer Science specialist
- Be able to teach Key Stage 3 and 4, up to GCSE level
- Be passionate about Computer Science, and committed to be committed to delivering lessons that will engage, enthuse and motivate our learners to succeed.
- Have excellent interpersonal and presentational skills
- Differentiate teaching to suit learners of different abilities
- Be forward-thinking, inspirational and receptive to change
- Be able to work independently

Applications from both NQTs and experienced teachers are welcome.

Starting salary is dependent on qualifications, skills and experience and will range from £21,000 - £30,000 per annum. There is an opportunity for this to become a full time role for a suitably qualified candidate on successful completion of a one year probationary period.
